Currently impact with Covid-19

- Food Banks- Higher demands in food banks due to Covid the families needing assistance has doubled. The food banks needing more volunteers.
- Children-In San Antonio most households with children were living with food insecurity before the Pandemic, now due to COVID-19 the estimated number is 18 million. Even more now with kids attending classes remotely from home.
- Military families-Some got less hours or were let go from their jobs, which led them to be dependent on the food bank.

What is it and how does the research help with Map the Meal Gap?

Food Insecurity Brief summarizes food insecurity based on current populations, unemployment, poverty, homeownership, and other demographic variables publicly available. Feeding America's mission to end hunger through a quantifiable and data- driven approach generated four types of community-level reports to assist in Mapping the Meal Gap. Those reports consist of overall foodinsecurity estimates, child food-insecurity estimates, average meal costs, and food budget shortfalls.

Map the Meal Gap

What is map the meal gap?

Map the Meal Gap aims to initiate data-driven conversations and insights about the reality of food insecurity in the United States and lay the foundation for evidence-based initiatives, strategies ,and actions to address it.

San Antonio, Texas

The food insecurity rate in San Antonio, more specifically, Bexar county, is 13.9%. That's 270,950 people who are experiencing food insecurity. The average meal cost is \$2.78. The additional money required to meet food needs is \$128,970,000





San Antonio Food Bank: Farmers Markets



What is the San Antonio Food Bank Farmers Market?

- The Farmers Market Nutrition Program (FMNP) allows qualified participants to buy nutritious fruits and vegetables using FMNP vouchers from participating Farmers Market Associations to improve their diets.
- The program promotes the routine consumption of healthy and fresh produce from Farmers Markets as a part of the daily diet of families and individuals we serve.
- Provides resources to WIC participants and seniors that qualify in the form of fresh, nutritious, unprepared, locally-grown fruits, vegetables, and culinary herbs from farmers markets.
- Increases the domestic consumption of agricultural commodities by helping develop or expand domestic farmers markets.

Why are these Farmers Markets so important?

- Offer affordable and healthy food options to seniors, moms and and young women which assist to live a more healthy life and set a standard of health for their families on an affordable budget/voucher program
- The program is already in place and supported by local governments
- Give support to local farmers and businesses to help in community financial gains

Criteria for Senior Vouchers SFMNP:

Seniors 60+ (income eligibility required)

Eligible WIC clients include:

- Pregnant Women
- Breastfeeding Women
- Postpartum Women
- Children ages 1-4

Voucher Program Details:

- Last day to obtain vouchers: September 30
- Vouchers expire October 31st
- We are unable to replace lost or stolen vouchers
- Products that are eligible to be purchased with vouchers are fruits and vegetables and honey for senior vouchers (please reference here for more details)

Conclusion

Team 3 explored food insecurity within the greater San Antonio area. We defined food insecurity and explained what organizations like Feeding America do to combat food insecurity. We described how the pandemic related to Coronavirus 19 had exasperated an already affected community.
